

PRIVACY NOTICE FOR SPEAK-UP LINE AND COMPLIANCE INVESTIGATIONS

Updated 09.04.2026

At Autoliv, we care about the safety of your data. In this notice, you will find information about how we manage information about you and how to exercise your data protection rights.

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR DATA?

Autoliv AB („Autoliv”), registered with the Swedish Companies Registration Office under company number 556687-7345 and with registered office at Klarabergsviadukten 70, Section D, 111 64, Stockholm, is processing your data on behalf of all legal entities in the Autoliv Group. Controllership and responsibility will be assumed by all Autoliv companies. All personal data processing is done following the applicable privacy legislation. WHAT PERSONAL DATA DO WE USE AND WHY?

Autoliv Helpline (“**Speak-up Line**” or “**Speak-up**”) is a web and phone-based intake system provided by Autoliv AB, open to its employees, former employees, or non-employees (this includes contractors, students, suppliers, partners, etc.) (“**Reporters**”) for reporting anonymously or with your name the suspected violations of laws or regulations, or for certain matters specifically specified in an applicable whistleblowing law as well as for raising a question on ethics or compliance matters or an inquiry regarding a company policy. The personal data processed as part of this process will allow you:

- To report suspected violations of law or company policies, as well as other concerns you may have, and to be able to investigate the alleged misconduct.

And/or

- To raise a question on ethics or compliance, or an inquiry regarding company policy, and to be able to offer you all the requested information

The following personal data will be processed:

Autoliv will protect the identity of the reporting person and any other information that may directly or indirectly reveal that identity and will restrict access to authorized persons on a strict need-to-know basis. Nevertheless, in exceptional cases, information capable of identifying the reporting person may need to be disclosed where such disclosure is necessary and legally required to carry out the follow-up, to take corrective measures, or to comply with legal or procedural obligations (including regulatory or judicial proceedings). Where applicable, you will be informed in advance that such information may be disclosed, unless providing you with such information hinders or impedes the investigation, the follow-up, or any measures taken in response to the report

WHO DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA WITH?

If we need to share your data, we ensure that such recipients process it in accordance with this notice, such as by entering into data transfer agreements or data processing agreements with the recipients. Those agreements include all reasonable and appropriate contractual, legal, technical, and organizational measures to ensure that your information is processed with an adequate level of protection and following the applicable law. Categories of recipients include:

- Autoliv companies within the Autoliv Group are listed [here](#). For processing and investigating the alleged misconduct and subject to the provisions of local law, the personal data and information you provide may be accessed, processed, and used by the relevant personnel of Autoliv or its affiliates or subsidiaries, including Management, Human Resources, Finance, IT, Internal Audit, Legal, Compliance, etc.
- System providers that Autoliv Group engages as processors. The personal information Autoliv collects from you is stored in one or more databases hosted by third parties. These third parties do not use or have access to your personal information for any purpose other than technical support.
- Subcontractors/consultants engaged by Autoliv to investigate under local applicable laws (e.g. legal advisors, lawyers, investigation companies)
- Authorities and law enforcement agencies, if requested for audit purposes or to verify compliance with legal requirements
- Legal or professional advisers, where necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims

We do not otherwise reveal your data to non-Autoliv persons or businesses for their independent use unless: (1) you request or authorize it; (2) the information is provided to comply with the law (for example, to comply with a search warrant, subpoena, or court order), enforce an agreement we have with you, or to protect our rights, property or safety, or the rights, property or safety of our employees or others; (3) the information is provided to our agents, vendors or service providers who perform functions on our behalf; (4) to address emergencies or acts of God; or (5) to address disputes, claims, or to persons demonstrating legal authority to act on your behalf; Those individuals and official authorities may be in one of the countries listed [here](#).

If we need to share your data, we ensure that such recipients process it in accordance with this notice, such as by entering into data transfer agreements or data processing agreements with the recipients. Those agreements include all reasonable and appropriate contractual, legal, technical, and organizational measures to ensure that your information is processed with an adequate level of protection and following the applicable law.

HOW DO WE ENSURE APPROPRIATE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA WHEN TRANSFERRED ACROSS BORDERS?

Autoliv always ensures that the same high level of protection applies to your data according to the [EU General Data Protection Regulation \[Regulation \(EU\) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons concerning the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC\]](#) and other applicable privacy acts, even when the data is transferred and processed outside of the jurisdiction you are operative in. Your rights concerning your data are not affected when data is transferred to a third country.

WHAT RIGHTS DO YOU HAVE RELATED TO THE PROCESSING OF YOUR DATA?

You have several rights related to your data and to receive information directly from us about how we process personal data about you. If you want to know more or meet us to exercise your rights and for other types of privacy questions, please email us at alv-dataprivacy@autoliv.com.

- **The right to have your data deleted**
You have the right to ask us to delete personal data about you, for example, personal data that we no longer need for the purpose it was collected for, or personal data that we process based on a consent that you wish to revoke.
- **Right to be informed**
You have the right to be informed of how we process your data. We inform you through this privacy notice, by general employee privacy notices issued from time to time, and by answering your questions at any given time.
- **Right to receive access to your data**
You have the right to know if Autoliv processes personal data about you, and to receive a copy (“data extract”) of such data. Through the data extract, you will receive information about what personal data we hold about you and how we process it.
- **Right to rectification**
You have the right to request that we rectify inaccurate information or complete information about you that you consider is inaccurate or incomplete.
- **Right to restrict processing**
If you believe that your data is inaccurate, that our processing is unlawful, or that we do not need certain information for a specific purpose, you have the right to request that we restrict the processing of such personal data. You can also request that we stop processing your data while we assess your request.
- **Right to object to our processing of your data**
You have the right to object to the processing your data, for example, when the processing is based on legitimate interest, by referencing your circumstances. When you object to our processing, you may also request us to restrict the processing of that personal data (as described above) while we make our assessment.
- **Right to object to an automated decision that significantly affects you**
You have the right to object to our use of automated decisions or conclusions if the decision produces legal effects or significantly similarly affects you. Please note that no automated decision-making is being conducted within the scope of the survey.

- **Right to withdraw your consent**

Where we process your data based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time.

- **Right to lodge a complaint**

If you have complaints about our processing of your personal data, you may lodge a complaint with the lead supervisory authority (<https://www.imy.se/en/individuals/forms-and-e-services/file-a-gdpr-complaint/>).
